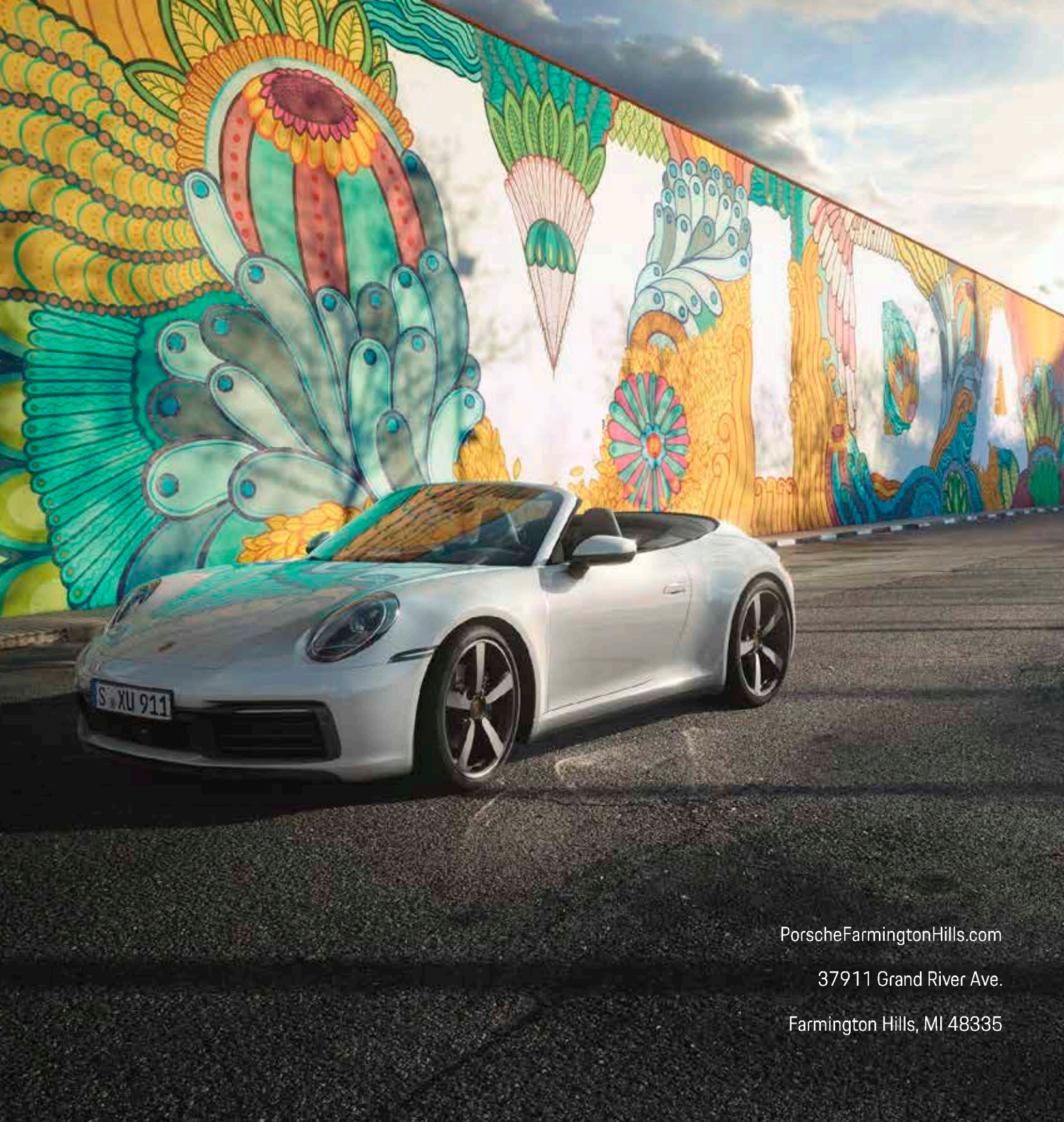

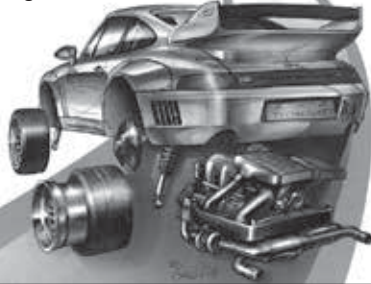

Thanks to my fellow Southeast Michigan PCA member Gary Ambrus, I recently attended the Greenfield Village Motor Muster at The Henry Ford. You might recall that Gary works as a presenter at Greenfield Village. Gary presented his 1977 Porsche Carrera in the Muster Popular Choice judging as he has done for several years. I was his guest with the ulterior motive to vote for his car in the judging. There were classes for several decades of vehicles from 1933 to 1949, 1950 to 1959, 1960 to 1964, 1965 to 1969 and 1979 to 1977. They included cars, motorcycles, bicycles, racing cars and commercial vehicles, both trucks and military, totaling about 650 vehicles. The majority of cars were American made and impeccably prepared for the people's choice voting. The Henry Ford staff carefully accepted vehicles for their originality as well as presentation. Trophies were handmade pottery from the Village's own pottery shop. The cars were all lined up on the lawns surrounding the Village buildings and connecting roads. A highlight was seeing a vintage car being driven on the roads to a presentation area where experts described each of them.

It was fascinating to talk with many of the owners of the displayed cars. For the most part these are single car collections and often passed down through generations. Many of the cars had minimal restoration, but still were near perfect in presentation. With the rare exception, these were also commonly known and not exotic models. That seemed to make the presentation all the more relatable and enjoyable for the spectators. There was a large turnout of spectators especially considering we are just coming out of a pandemic. Most surprising were how many families turned out and the propensity of young people. Also, the Village does very well with staff presenters dressed in period costume. There were daylong period themed musical concerts and educational displays as well as many food concessions.

As always, a trip to Greenfield Village is a wonderful way to decompress from today's world and step back to an era that was in many ways slower paced and full of the classic traditions. Cars of the bygone days made a statement of whom you were and where you were going. We had little concern then for exhaust emissions or fuel

mileage. Cars were large and built for big roads and long trips. They certainly brought big smiles to the many visitors. For others it was a trip down memory lane for those who had once owned one of these classics. ■

Ohio 555 and Hocking Hills Tour Recap

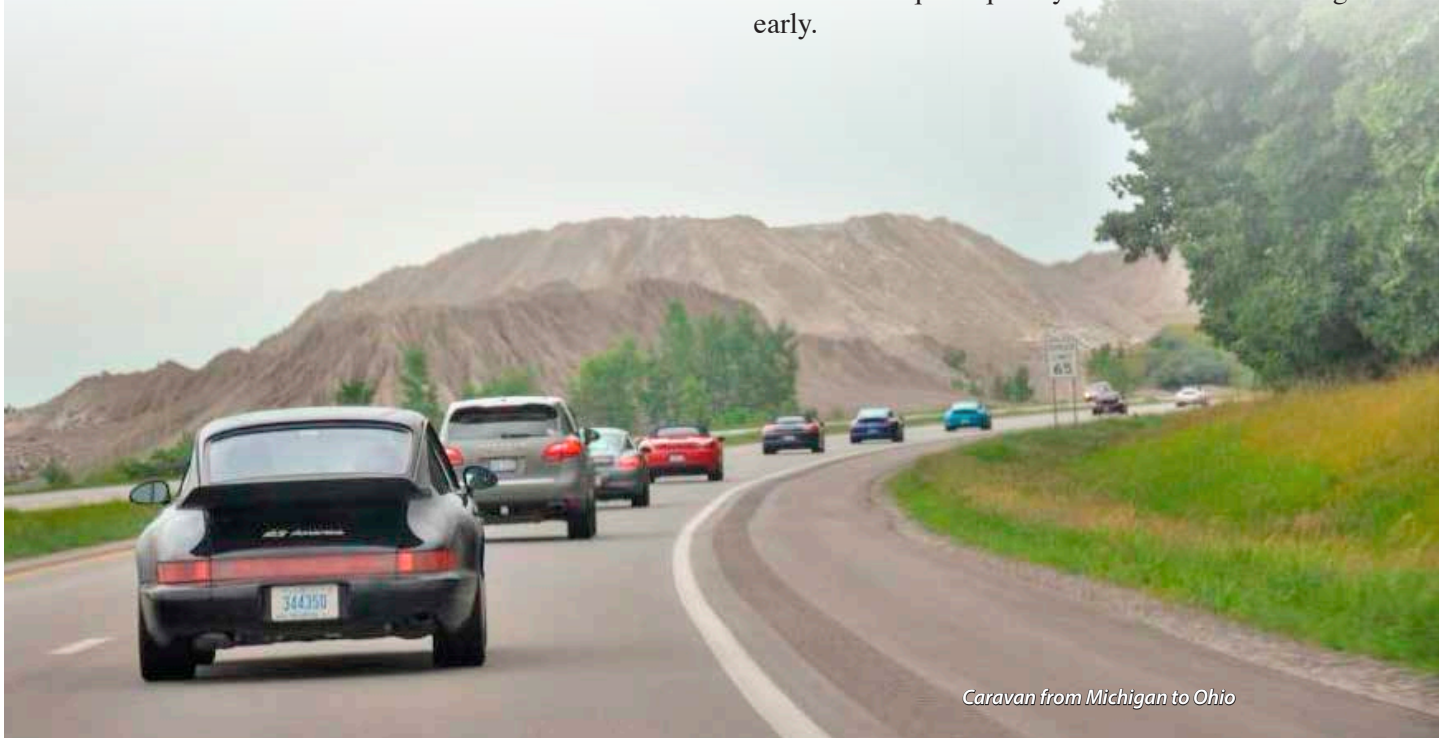
Due to the popularity of the last overnight driving tour to the Tail of the Dragon, we decided to continue with these types of extended driving tours. We searched for a fun curvy road that was not more than 3-4 hours from us. During our route search, we came across an article from Car and Driver on the 12 best roads in America. Ohio 555 is one of them along with their Hocking Hills test loop.

Ohio 555: Considered to be one of the more challenging roads in Ohio, the Triple Nickel rewards drivers who are up for a good challenge. Many say this road is just as fun as the Tail of the Dragon, but many agree that the Triple Nickel provides a completely different type of fun than the Dragon. While the Dragon gives you a series of smooth cambered twists and expected curves, the Triple Nickel is full of tight off-camber curves, rises and quick turns.

Hocking Hills: Car and Driver has used this loop since at least 1989. It's less than 14 miles according to Google Maps, a bit shorter than the Nord-schleife. Decades of testers have settled on this repeatable loop as a go-to automotive fitness course.

Once we decided to do Ohio 555 and Hocking Hills, we brought the idea to our SEM board and they quickly approved the event. Our Zone 4 Rep, Lori Schultz, suggested that we should talk to the Mid-Ohio Region since they are local to this area and they have done this before. SEM and MOR got in touch and decided it is a good idea to join forces to bring our members a driving tour where we can drive our Porsches the way they were meant to be driven.

Planning started in January. Jose Isern from MOR, Chris Bohr and I started planning the route. Jim and Laurie Williams researched a hotel for the group. We initially estimated and planned the event for 40 vehicles. We opened registration in March and surpassed our limit in less than 2 weeks. We went back to re-evaluate our plan and determined our main restriction was the lunch/rest stop location. We had to move the stop location to a larger facility and Burr Oaks Lodge near OH-555 came to the rescue. With that, we managed to increase the capacity to 60 cars (~90 people). Even with this increased capacity, we filled our quota quickly and had to close the registration early.

On Friday before the main drive event, we planned to have a caravan from Michigan to our hotel in Ohio with me as the lead and organizer. Of course, like other events I have organized (Three Spring and Fall Color Tours), we got hit by a heavy rain and storms. We had to slow down, but made it to the hotel safely and in time for a dinner together. After dinner John Shoemake pointed out that there was a Billy Strings concert just 15 minutes away from our hotel and a few members went to watch the wonderful concert.

We started the main event at 9 AM on Saturday from a parking lot in front of Bob Evan's restaurant. Sixty three cars from SEM and MOR participated. We divided the cars into six groups with Howard Gilson, Chris Bohr and Andrew Vincent leading three of the groups. We started the drive from the city of Granville and headed straight to OH-555. After driving half of OH-555 we stopped at Burr Oaks Lodge for lunch at noon.

During the lunch stop, we could hear the excitement about the drive as people were talking about how the road would rise up and end with a sudden off-camber blind turn at the top. Everyone loved the road. We purposely planned a long lunch stop to allow participants to socialize while their food was being digested before driving the second half of the route.

We left on the second half of the route close to 2 PM. After driving the remainder of OH-555 we headed to Hocking Hills. We got lucky as traffic was not too heavy and we still could enjoy the fun twisty road without getting stuck behind slower vehicles.
