Staying Relevant

A writer once asked Ferry Porsche how he knew who the competition was for his line of cars. His reply was that the competition was not other cars, but was unrelated objects such as airplanes, yachts and cottages. His point was that people with large disposable incomes have lots of competition for what holds their interest and is relevant to their life style. In this increasingly turbulent era we all are even more challenged not only to sort out what is true and relevant, but even what is true from what is false. How does this even relate to Porsche much less PCA? Without appearing shallow or self-centered, we have to daily balance many events and opportunities that shape our demands on time and commitments.

As a Porsche owner and PCA member, we have lots of options depending on our interests. If we are focused primarily on performance we might be more interested in a line of sports cars like the 911 Carrera, Boxster or Cayman. We then might want to participate in track events with those cars. If we are more interested in luxury and practicality, then we might lean more toward the Panamera or Taycan. Your driving interests might be less track inclined and more socially interactive. If you are more interested in utility, even to the point of off road capability, you have the choices of the Cayenne or Macan and PCA has started to create the off road driving experience

Such diversity in car production results not only in a wide diversity of car models, but also in car owners. Porsche has to find ways to make their different car models relevant to a diversity of owners and their interests. Can it really be possible that a single owner would have one of each model of Porsche? Is it in Porsche's interest to have a corresponding car to match each of their competitors' line of models? With the introduction of gas and electric hybrids, will Porsche match the market to remain relevant? Even more so, how will it match the conversion to a full electric line of cars? The even bigger challenge will be to convince the customer base to alter their car interests to this fully electric line of cars. As more manufacturers narrow their car lines to focus on more profitable models, will Porsche follow that direction? Unlikely as it might sound, could we see a pickup in Porsche's future? Fortunately, in

that regard Porsche is part of a much larger conglomerate and can cover the pickup with a VW.

The diversity of the car market might also end up altering the diversity of PCA. Things that would seemingly have no relationship to a car club actually influence the relevancy between car ownership and how we see ourselves interacting through club activities. Already with soaring gas prices I find myself being more selective on participating in club activities. With all of the stresses of today, I find it harder and harder to balance out social responsibility with the larger scope of humanitarian demands such as global warming. Does it really matter what the top speed of my electric hyper car is when I am gradually losing the roads I can drive that car on? For now car racing has stayed relevant, but how long will that last? We already saw racing go to computer simulated competition when the pandemic hit and it could happen again. We already have PCA computer simulation racing, so how far of a reach would it be to see computer simulated driver education events?

So how does my car life style and car centric society keep all of these interests relevant? Can car advertising and marketing keep my Porsche interests relevant? When the Pandemic hit we were all suddenly confronted with the realization that what we thought was relevant was all nonessential. Sports and sporting crowds suddenly ceased. I can remember with depressing shock watching computer simulation racing and sporting events with no crowds and cardboard cutouts of people propped up in the seats. Social events and sporting events are faced with new protocols that also affect much of our working and social lives. As much as we want to understand the future and our role it, we have to accept that keeping all things relevant is an ever increasing challenge. Although I don't pretend to know how to keep everything relevant, I can enjoy the challenge and the opportunities in front of me. ■

Seven weeks after attending the chilly 24 Hours of Daytona, we again found ourselves in Florida. This time, we were a bit deeper into the state and really felt some Florida heat at the 12 Hours of Sebring.

The sounds were familiar, most of the cars were familiar, but this track was a true road course and the search for prime viewing locations was part of the challenge each pp==day. Just as we did at Daytona, we immediately soughtout the Porscheplatz. A respite from the beating sun, the tent afforded us the opportunity to sit in shade, enjoy some cool hydration and watch live large-screen coverage of the racing. Best of all it provided a centralized location to meetup with friends, both expected and happily, unexpected, before heading into the infield or viewing Turn 17 from the stands within the Porscheplatz. Sadly we had not secured Corral parking in advance, but the numerous other PCA members attending the race filled the area completely. And what a sight it was!

> Like most races, there is a mix of carnival, music concert, elite box seating and tent/trailer/motor coach camping in combination with the actual racing. It is a gastronomic and sensory overload at times. Even if you haven't been to a county fair in years, it is possible to satisfy all long-time favorite carnival food cravings at weekend races. Envision funnel cakes, handmade ice cream, food trucks with fare that Guy Fieri would praise and just about any kind of beverage.


Not only is the track and all the activities fun to experience, but the infield is a sight to see with people from all over the world coming to watch and camp/live for multiple days. Some of the layouts/structures that people erect are really great to see. At one stretch along the track there is what looks like a small Western town and numerous other welldesigned viewing and seating set ups, think scaffolding plus elevated patios, to watch the cars go by through the day and into the night.

We arrived at Sebring on Thursday and returned on Friday and again on Saturday for the 12-Hour race. There isn't just one race, there are numerous practice and qualifying sessions plus many races over the days preceding the main event. Every time the track is hot, there is an over-arching adrenaline buzz for drivers and spectators alike.

Come Saturday morning, we arrived for The Race - the 12 Hours of Sebring. The few minutes before a race are some of the most emotional. Something about the sun rising, the huge cross-section of fans, the harnessed excitement and the silent reverent stillness that immediately descends throughout the entire race complex by the end of the phrase "Oh say can you see?" Then the engines fire-up and you can hear and slowly start to feel the DP leaders on the first formation lap long before you see them round the curve. you along into the full-on excitement of the race that is one or two laps away from starting.

The race started with a field of 53. By race end, 43 cars crossed the finish line. For the GTD PRO series, in which Porsche runs, the top Porsches were the Pfaf Motorsports GT3 R in 20th and the Weather Tech Racing GT3R in 21st. The HardPoint team's GT3R in 33rd and the Wright Motorsports GT3R in 37th were the top finishers from our favorite brand in GTD. To see all these great cars running around this well-driven (aka: bumpy) historic track and to see so many able to stay running and finish was amazing. Hope you have the chance to experience it yourself inperson some time.






