



#### The Beauty Curse

Owning a beautiful car brings with it a lot of responsibility. Simple pride of ownership will drive us to make many sacrifices for the sake of the car. With the responsibility comes the reward of open admiration from your friends, family and often even complete strangers. But do we need a beautiful car to realize the fun of car ownership? Think back to those first cars you owned. Most likely their beauty was only in the eyes of the owner, not the beholder. Did that make them any less fun to own or drive?

My car ownership started with a modest 1967 VW Beetle. It received constant polishing of its deep blue paint and every chrome aftermarket part J. C. Whitney had to offer. The curse began shortly after with a dark green 914-6. Suddenly I was caught up in the mysteries of car polish. A club seminar on car detailing was my downfall. Does anyone remember Classic Wax's Slipstream wax? Classic made an automotive carnauba based wax, but Slipstream wax was formulated for airplane use. I put it on everything, including the windows. I applied it with my fingertips so that it would go on smoothly and thinly. Every couple of months it got another application. When I switched to a 911, the obsession became complete. I then needed a daily driver.

The daily driver may be a nice clean car, but it is not "the beauty" and thus it is not obsessed over. You can take the daily driver to any function or destination and not worry over where it will be parked or if it will be in favorable weather. It can acquire the occasional stone chip or door ding without incurring a personal crisis. My most fun daily driver was a car rescued from the scrap yard. A friend owned a 1970 Mazda RX2 coupe in bright orange. It was on its way to the junk yard because it would stall within a minute of being fired up. I gave him \$50 and flat towed it home on a rope. It took several weeks to discover the green electrical connections causing the problem. It then gave me somewhat faithful service for over 150,000 more miles. The best part about that car was the rust, but it also was its ultimate end. I could drive and park that car with impunity. No decent car would challenge me. Driving without a care was a blast. I will admit that I did wax it annually. It also greatly improved my bondo skills. When the steering box

rusted off the frame it was time to retire it back to the junk yard.

The replacement 944 was not as carefree. I tried not to care about that car, but my conscience just would not let me. It was quite an indulgence to have a 944 as a daily driver. As the odometer cleared 175,000 miles the car still looked good with its rust proof body, but I worried how long it would be mechanically sound. At that time I still had the 911, plus a red 914-6 GT that my brother-in-law's body shop had restored to show car condition. In fact, it was too pretty to drive. Rather than subject it to garage queen status I sold it to a 914-6 collector in Washington State and I gave the 944 to my brother. That left me with the garage space and budget to pursue a different variety of daily driver. A friend knew of a garage queen 1999 Corvette that needed to be rescued. I wondered if it really could be a daily driver, snow and all. The Corvette was nice, but not pristine and did track duty and street duty with equal aplomb. It even got phenomenal gas mileage.

As the Corvette approached 170,000 miles the same worries came back with its rust impervious body, but fallible mechanicals. Every creak or rattle foretold impending doom. With lust in my heart, I replaced one Corvette with a slightly newer 2007 model. But, it has brought me full circle to the problems of having a beautiful car. This Corvette is a black Z06 with just 10,000 miles. It sits next to the gorgeously restored 911 in my garage, with both cars under car covers. I will be obsessed over washing and polishing it and worry about where it is parked and what roads I drive it on. Also, what will I drive in the winter? It is a wonderful track car that I will no doubt pamper. I could have learned the lesson that your dream car sometimes is better off left in your dreams. But, then I remembered my mantra that life is too short to drive a dumb car and the responsibility of owning a beautiful car is totally worth it.
