

ARTICLE BY TOM FIELITZ

Bespoke is one of those uncommonly used words originally associated with custom made suits, but has spread to most any exclusively made product including automobiles. You may be familiar with specialty Porsche car manufacturers like Singer, Tuthill or Theon. These companies will make a 911 Carrera to your exact specification starting with the restoration of an existing used Porsche. The cost is very high, but the quality of the work reflects the craftsmanship in a car built to a higher standard than original. Being an astute company, Porsche was quick to recognize a new profit center and a marketing need they could fulfill in a much more customer desirable way.

Porsche created an extension of their Stuttgart manufacturing plant called Sonderwunsch translated to "Special Wishes". When I toured the Porsche Stuttgart plant back in 1970, it was just adjacent to the 911 assembly building that also handled production and maintenance of racing cars. Volume was very low and consisted of retrofitting special customer requests not normally available as a production line option listed in the standard catalogue. The most common option was custom paint color, including paint to match and custom interior coverings. Over the years this bespoke process was expanded to the Exclusive Manufakaktur and Classic Divisions. These operations can produce custom one off cars as well as fully commissioned and restored models. Porsche Exclusive produces about 1,000 cars per year. The process can involve virtually the entire company at a cost is no object level. This included very limited production models. As an example, there was a very limited production run of the carbon fiber chassis 918 with its battery hybrid and racing exclusive engine. When a customer wrecked his 918 he requested a replacement though it was long out of production. Through extensive research, Porsche determined they had just enough replacement parts, including one last chassis, which they could use to produce a whole car. How much would a replacement million dollar car cost? That is where cost is no object comes in I guess. These divisions are also responsible for the very special edition cars with exclusively short production runs.

The Exclusive Division has focused on the 911 and 718, but there is no reason to exclude the Panamera, Cayenne and Macan as these models are already available with their own extensive catalog of options. What is even more intriguing is where Porsche will go with the Taycan as Porsche says it already comes with a more extensive catalogue of options than the rest of the car lines. While there are almost no limit to what you can wish for, they have drawn the limit on converting existing cars to electric power, at least until the electric Carrera becomes a reality. There is also the limitation that they will not copy or draw features from other manufacturers.

Restoring models 10 years or more after the end of their production run is also a growing market. Considering that there are some 870,000 eligible cars on the road this could be a very lucrative market. To that point, Porsche has created 75 certified Porsche Classic Partners around the world as well as four locations dealing exclusively with the classic lines. They have committed to creating around 300 new spare parts per year starting in 2013 and over 60,000 existing spare parts are currently available in their catalog including a growing line of performance parts.

The days of special ordering your new Porsche are long behind us, but the days ahead offer a new opportunity well beyond our special wishes.

Business Meeting Minutes* (10/06/22) by Fred Young

OCTOBER 6, 2022


