

<u>Car Safety Technical Inspection</u> <u>- 60 Days -</u>

Welcome!! Thank you for participating in a Southeast Michigan Porsche Club of America - High Performance Driver Education event. Below you will find the latest Car Safety Technical Inspection form. Note that some things have changed from previous years, please read the following carefully.

Here are a few key points you need to be aware of:

- This form consists of three (3) pages. The first two contain Section A and are the majority of the Pre-Track safety checks. **DRIVER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING THIS COMPLETED, ORIGINAL TECH INSPECTION FORM TO EACH EVENT.** This original form will be retained by the participant. The third page contains Section B, the Final Safety Inspection (Grid Tech). A new, blank version of this page is to be printed and brought to **EACH EVENT**. This will be completed at the track and turned in at the event for the hosting Region to retain.
- The driver must be able to present the hosting Region the Original Technical Safety Inspection form upon request. <u>IF THE ORIGINAL TECHNICAL INSPECTION FORM IS NOT PRESENTED</u>, <u>THE CAR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT</u>.
- A Safety Technical Inspection form must be completed for EVERY vehicle registered.
- This inspection may be valid for 60 days from date of inspection. (barring any incidents)
- This inspection and form (section A) may only be completed by one of the following:
 - Specialty repair shop or independent Porsche mechanic
 - Porsche or other dealership
 - PCA Region authorized tech inspector
 - PCA tech inspector approved by other Region safety chair
- If the car has been involved in an incident that require a Region to file a PCA Incident Report or experienced a mechanical or technical failure on track, this Inspection Form is no longer valid and a new Pre-Track Inspection Form must be completed.
